(For the First Saturdays of Reparation to The Immaculate Heart of Mary
Book: Treasures of First Saturday Devotion by Fr. Andrew Apostoli, C.F.R.)

Opening SongIn Fatima's Cove

Almighty Father, I place the Precious Blood of Jesus before my lips before I pray, that my prayers, may be purified before they ascend to Thy divine altar. (St. Mary Magdalen de Pazzi)

Let us acknowledge the presence of our God ... In the name of the Father, & of the Son & of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Invoke the Holy Spirit *(all together)*

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in us the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and we shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in His consolation, through Christ Our Lord, Amen.

Act of Contrition *(all together)*

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee; I detest all my sins because I fear the loss of heaven and the pains of hell. But most of all, I offended Thee, O my God who art so good and deserving all my love. I firmly intend to do penance and to amend my life. Amen.

Spiritual Communion *(all together)*

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

Offering to the Eternal Father *(all together)*

Eternal Father, we offer Thee the Most Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son Jesus, in

union with the masses said throughout the world today, for all the Holy Souls in Purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal church, those in my own home and within my family, Amen.

Prayer to Our Lady of Fatima*(all together)*

Most Holy Virgin, you came to Fatima to reveal to three little children the treasure of graces hidden in the recitation of the Rosary. Inspire my heart with a sincere love of this devotion so that, by meditating on the mysteries of our redemption that it recalls, I may gather the fruits and obtain the special grace which I ask of you during these fifteen minutes for the greater glory of God, for your honor, and for the good of souls. 1st Sorrowful Mystery – The Agony in the Garden (Matthew 26:36-46)

Let us consider in this mystery – how on Holy Thursday after Jesus had instituted the Holy Eucharist, accompanied by His disciples, He went to Mount Olivet, where there was a garden called Gethsemane.

And He said to them, "My soul is sorrowful even to death. Remain here and keep watch with me." Then falling upon His face, He prayed, saying: "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet, not as I will but as you will."

Thus Jesus prayed three times, and fell into an agony and His sweat became as drops of blood, trickling down to the ground. And there appeared an angel, who strengthened Him. Then Jesus arose, found His disciples asleep and said to them: "Are you still sleeping and taking your rest? Behold, the hour is at hand when the Son of Man is to be handed over to sinners. Get up, let us go. Look, my betrayer is at hand."

Prayer (all together): *Immaculate Heart of Mary, by the overwhelming anguish and grief Our Savior suffered in His Agony, I pray for the grace to respond to your request at Fatima: "Sacrifice yourselves for sinners, and say many times, especially whenever you make some sacrifice: O Jesus, it is for love of You, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary."*

Fruit of the mystery: Acceptance of God's Will.

Pray: Our Father...; Hail Mary, ten times; Glory be...

O my Jesus! Forgive us our sins, save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need.

Jesus, Protect and Save the Unborn. Amen.

O Mary conceived without sin,
Pray for us who have recourse to thee.

Chant Fatima Ave, Ave, Ave...

2nd Sorrowful Mystery – Scourging at the Pillar (Luke 23:1-22 & John 19:1)

Let us consider in this mystery – how, in the early morning, Jesus was led before the Roman Governor, Pontius Pilate, to be tried.

But Pilate knew that Jesus had been delivered by the envy of the priests and Pharisees and He said to them: "You brought this man to me and accused him of inciting the people to revolt. I have conducted my investigation in your presence and have not found this man guilty of the charges you have brought against him, nor did Herod, for he sent him back to us. So, no capital crime has been committed by him. Therefore, I shall have him flogged and release him."

Jesus was then led away, stripped of His garments and tied to a pillar, where He was most inhumanly scourged by cruel executioners.

His Precious Blood streamed from His flesh mangled by so many blows.

Prayer (all together): *Immaculate Heart of Mary, Jesus suffered this inhuman punishment to atone for the sins of man. You revealed to Jacinta that many souls go to hell because of sins of the flesh. Grant me the virtue of purity so I may never cause myself or my neighbor the loss of heaven. May the words of Jacinta become my own: "But I offer everything for sinners, and in reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary...Our Lord and our Lady greatly love those who suffer for the conversion so sinners."*

Fruit of the Mystery: Purity of Intention

Pray: Our Father...; Hail Mary, ten times; Glory be...

O my Jesus! Forgive us our sins, save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need.

Jesus, Protect and Save the Unborn. Amen.

3rd Sorrowful Mystery – The Crowning with Thorns (Matthew 27:26-31)

Let us consider in this mystery – how, after Jesus had been scourged, Pilate delivered Him up to be crucified. The soldiers of the procurator took Jesus into the praetorium and gathered together about Him the whole cohort.

As they stripped Him of His garments and put on Him a scarlet cloak; and plaiting a crown of thorns, they put it upon His head and a reed into His right hand; and bending the knee before Him they mocked Him, saying "Hail, King of the Jews!" Others spat on Him, and took the reed and struck His head.

At last, they blindfolded Him and renewed all manner of insult and injury.

Prayer (all together): *Immaculate Heart of Mary, at Tuy, Sr. Lucia was blessed to see the Trinity, with Jesus Crucified, above the altar. His Precious drops of Blood were spilling into His chalice. From His side, rivers of water spilled forth over the altar with the words, "Graces and Mercy." Your Immaculate Heart was there, also. I pray, be with me as I approach the altar that I may receive worthily His grace and mercy, remembering the words of the Angel at Fatima: "Take and drink the body and blood of Jesus Christ, horribly outraged by ungrateful men! Make reparation for their crimes and console your God."*

Fruit of the Mystery: Contrition

Pray: Our Father...; Hail Mary, ten times; Glory be...

O my Jesus! Forgive us our sins, save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need.

Jesus, Protect and Save the Unborn. Amen.

O Mary conceived without sin,
Pray for us who have recourse to thee.

Chant Fatima Ave, Ave, Ave....

4th Sorrowful Mystery - The Carrying of the Cross (Mark 15:20-26)

Let us consider in this mystery – how the soldiers seized Jesus, removed His scarlet cloak and put on His own garments.

A heavy cross is placed upon His bleeding shoulder and He is led away to be crucified. Each step on this agonizing journey causes terrific pain throughout His torn body. The cross cut deeply into His wounded shoulder. He struggled along to Calvary, stumbling and falling beneath the heavy weights of the cross amidst the shouts and jeers of His own people. Finally, they came to a place called Golgotha, that is, the Place of the Skull.

Prayer (all together): *Immaculate Heart of Mary, with compassion I recall how painful it must have been for you to see Jesus suffering for the sins of man. Inspire me with a keen sorrow for my past sins. In moments of trial, may I remember your promise: "Are you suffering a great deal? Do not lose hope, I will not forsake you." Your words to the three little shepherds bring forth your maternal concern for me: "Do not offend the Lord anymore, because he is already so much offended." I desire never to offend God again.*

Fruit of the Mystery: Patience

Pray: Our Father...; Hail Mary, ten times; Glory be...

O my Jesus! Forgive us our sins, save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need.

Jesus, Protect and Save the Unborn. Amen.

5th Sorrowful Mystery – The Crucifixion (Luke 23:33-46 and John 19:16-30)

Let us consider in this mystery – how, when Jesus reached the top of Mount Calvary, He was stripped of His garments and then cruelly nailed to the cross.

The two robbers where crucified with Him reached the top of Mount Calvary, He was stripped of His garments and then cruelly nailed to the cross.

The two robbers were crucified with Him, one on His right hand, and one on His left. And the people mocked Jesus, saying: "He saved others, let him save himself if he is the chosen one, the Messiah of God."

Jesus spoke: "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do."

One of the thieves who was crucified with Him blasphemed Jesus saying: "Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us."

But the other rebuked him and exclaimed: "Have you no fear of God, for you are subject to the same condemnation? And indeed, we have been condemned justly, for

the sentence we received corresponds to our crimes, but this man has done nothing criminal." Then, he said: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

Jesus answered: "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

Then Jesus looked down from His cross and beheld His Mother, Mary, and John. His beloved disciple, Jesus said to His Mother: "Woman, behold your son." And to John, He said, "Behold your mother." From that hour John took the mother of Jesus to himself, as if she were his own mother.

And when the sixth hour came, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour. And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out in a loud voice, saying: "My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?"

Soon afterward Jesus exclaimed: "I thirst." Then a soldier took a sponge soaked in common wine, put it on a reed and gave it to Him to drink. After He had taken the wine Jesus said: "It is finished." Then he cried out in a loud voice: "Father, into your hands, I commend My spirit." He then bowed His head and died.

Prayer (*all together*): *Immaculate Heart of Mary, for the sake of the bitter anguish you suffered at the foot of the cross, help me to be charitable to all who offend me and to offer and make sacrifices in supplication for the conversion of sinners. At Fatima, you showed the three shepherd children a vision of hell: "You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go..." Grant me the grace to overcome evil in moments in temptation, especially at my last hour. Your words to Sr. Lucia sustain me: "I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months..."*

Fruit of the Mystery: Perseverance

Pray: Our Father...; Hail Mary, ten times; Glory be...

O my Jesus! Forgive us our sins, save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need.

Jesus, Protect and Save the Unborn. Amen.

Chant Fatima Ave, Ave, Ave....

In response to the request of our Lady, our Blessed Mother Mary, we are now going to quiet ourselves for 15 minutes to meditate on the Sorrowful Mysteries we just prayed... When it's over, you will be prompt in praying the Hail, Holy Queen... The 15-minute meditation starts now...

At the conclusion of the 15-minute quiet meditation, the moderator will announce the praying of the Hail Holy Queen...

HAIL! HOLY QUEEN, Mother of Mercy, hail our life, our sweetness and our hope. To you do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To you do we send our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, O most gracious advocate, your eyes of mercy toward us; and after this our exile show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

Pray for us, O most Holy Mother of God.

(R): That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.
