1st Mystery – The Resurrection (Matthew 28:5-8)

“Then the angel said to the women in reply, ‘Do not be afraid! I know that you are seeking Jesus the crucified. He is not here, for he has been raised just as he said...go quickly and tell his disciples, “He has been raised from the dead, and he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him.” Behold, I have told you.’ Then they...ran to announce this to his disciples.”

Meditation

Faith is a gift of God. It is a virtue that allows us to submit to the belief of the things of God that are known but not yet seen. Faith opens “the eyes of [our] hearts [to] be enlightened.” (Ephesians 1:18a) For we know our salvation was won, not only by Christ’s Death on the Cross, but also through His Resurrection to life. And it is through our faith in the risen Lord that we know our own bodies will also rise from the dead; then we truly will be able to see God with the eyes of our hearts in Heaven.

2nd Mystery – The Ascension (Mark 16:19-20, Hebrews 13:14)

“So then the Lord Jesus, after he spoke to them, was taken up into heaven and took his seat at the right hand of the God. But they went forth and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the word through accompanying signs.”

Meditation

During the Last Supper, Jesus tells His disciples, “I am going to prepare a place for you.”(John 14:2b) Our Lord departs from us, not to separate Himself from the world, but to take His place in glory at the right hand of His Father, while continuing to love and assist us in our own journeys. It is through the merits of Christ’s Death and Resurrection that we are able to hope in an afterlife. We therefore place our trust and hope in God, “[f]or here we have no lasting city, but we seek the one that is to come.”

3rd Mystery – The Descent of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-4, John 14:16)

“And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enables them to proclaim.

Meditation

There is no gift greater than the gift of God’s love.”...I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always.” It is through these words that Jesus infuses us with the gift of the Holy Comforter, the great Advocate who dwells in our hearts. The movements and inspirations of the Holy Spirit are evidence of God’s love working within us. We strive to allow ourselves to be docile to His holy will, so that in imitation of Our Lady we also might become a conduit for God to work in the world.

4th Mystery – The Assumption of Mary Into Heaven (Revelation 12:1-6, Luke 1:49)

With expectation and longing for Heaven, Mary ends Her earthly life. She is assumed Body and Soul into Heaven.

Meditation

The deep love and power of God preserves Our Lady from the stains of sin and corruption, in both body and soul. “The Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name.” Aside from Jesus, Mary is the sole person over whom evil has no power. Mary’s perfect purity has not been marred by sin, and she thus has a greater capacity to know, love, and be united with our Lord. He therefore calls Mary to Himself in her entirety. God’s call to Mary is fueled by the same desire He has for all of us to join Him, body and soul, in eternal happiness.

Grace of the Mystery: Desire for heaven and grace of a happy death.

Pray: Our Father, once; Hail Mary, ten times; Glory be to the Father, once; and O my Jesus...

Prayer: May the grace of the mysteries of the Immaculate Conception and the Assumption of Mary, come down into my soul and make me truly devoted to Her.

5th Mystery – The Coronation of the Blessed Mother as Queen of Heaven and Earth (Revelation 12:1)

“A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.”

Meditation

The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit crown Our Lady as Queen of Heaven and earth. Reigning in perfect union with her beloved Son, Christ the King, she is both Mother and Queen, a status which grants her special authority in petitioning Our Lord for our needs. Just as Jesus responds generously to Mary’s intercession at the wedding feast at Cana, when we pray for Our Lady’s intercession, she is able to attain for us through her Son all that we need for our salvation.

Grace of the Mystery: Faithful devotion to Mary.
